This morning I received word from CECV stating that regional schools would also remain online in Week One of Term Four, with a return to onsite learning on October 12<sup>th</sup>. This week we will discuss as a staff how the first week of term will look in terms of learning and will advise families on this as soon as possible.

According to yesterday's announcement, regional Victoria may see alterations to the restrictions as time goes on, depending on numbers of COVID cases. We all await these changes with baited breath!
